

## 2016 "Road to Victory" Program:

The goal of this is to get out and ride and experience some sites you might not have thought about. There are two different chances to win....one for the rider with over 10k miles and one for under 10k miles. Here is how it works and what you need to do to be a part of the challenge:

First, you must submit a picture via text or email to me of your odometer at the beginning of the riding season. No picture – no entry! (Text to Jim Dever)

Second, just get out and ride!

Third, as you earn a point please post a picture as proof to the BVRRC Facebook page, include the points earned as well as your total points for the year so everyone can track your progress. This must be done in real time, so NO sandbagging! If you are not on Facebook, please text picture to Jim D.

### Point System (No pics – no points!)

Earn 1 point for each of the following:

- Each state in the lower 48 (max of 48 pts)
- Any National Park, Forest, Cemetery, or National Monument
- Any Civil War Battlefield Memorial
- Any Revolutionary War Battlefield Memorial
- Any Victory Dealer
- Each B-dawg Road trip

Earn 2 points for each of the following:

- Each of the Four corner States (ME,FL,CA,WA-max total of 8 for all 4)
- Each of the selected Motorcycle Rallies
- Each of the "Top 10 Routes"
- Every 5,000 miles in 2016
- Cross into Mexico or Canada(Just like the states- points only awarded once)

Earn 3 points for each of the following: (Awarded once)

- 1,000 miles in 24hrs (per IBA rules)

Earn 4 points for each of the following: (Awarded once)

- Pacific to Atlantic trip
- 1500 miles in 24hrs (per IBA rules)

Earn 5 points for each of the following: (Awarded once)

- 2000 miles in 48hrs (per IBA rules)
- Most miles ridden in the year
- Ride to Alaska
